
We do hope that you all had the chance to relax a little over the recent Easter break and are really pleased to see you all again. We have some exciting news for you and a few requests too!

SELF-REGISTRATION IN NURSERY

You may have already noticed our self-registration photos in our keyperson areas in Nursery. We are encouraging the children to add their photo to the next available space on the left. It is a great way for the children to begin to use positional language including next to, at the top underneath and also to use ordinal language including first, second, last. Additionally we are talking with the children

about a 'full five frame' and needing to start on the next five frame. These are all useful skills to support the children's concepts of number.

MUD KITCHEN MAKEOVER - A FANTASTIC WORK IN PROGRESS!

We are often very busy making and creating in our magnificent mud kitchens. As with most kitchens, sometimes they need a bit of a revamp and ours are just the same!
